

ANNUAL STVDPC “CHURCH FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP”

CALLING ALL SVDPC SOON TO BE GRADUATING HIGH SCHOOL SENIORS

In June of each year, the St. Vincent de Paul Church family who throughout the year have generously donated to the parish Scholarship Fund awards a one time grant of up to \$1000.00 as funds permit to each graduating high school senior who has and continues to be an active member of the St. Vincent de Paul Church family and plans to continue their formal education at an accredited school, college or university following graduation.

The following are the qualifications for a student to receive this grant:

1. Must be graduating from an accredited high school in the year that the grant is to be awarded or must have successfully completed equivalent requirements, such as, but not limited to, an accredited home school or GED program.
2. Must have included as part of their life regular active participation in the church and community; that is, including but not limited to, regularly attended formation classes or the equivalent (Catholic school), as reported by their class teachers, and regularly participated in church youth activities and community volunteer activities.
3. Submitted no later than ***the 3rd Sunday of May of the year that you will graduate*** a one page letter addressed to Father John Bosco Walugembe, our Pastor, telling why you deserve to receive this grant, keeping in mind, but not limited to, the qualifications listed above.
